Proposal for a Legislative Amendment of the Constitution eliminating the Word "Pauper."

1 A joint session of the senate and house of repre-
2 sentatives hereby declares it to be expedient to alter
3 the constitution by the adoption of the following
4 article of amendment, to the end that it may be
5 come a part of the constitution, if similarly agreed
6 to in a joint session of the next general court and
7 approved by the people at the state election next
8 following:

9 ARTICLE OF AMENDMENT.

10 Article III of the amendments to the constitution
11 as amended, is hereby further amended by striking
12 out, in the second line, the words "paupers and."
