To accompany the petition of P. Eugene Casey for legislation relative to the retirement of certain State employees. Pensions.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Thirty-Six.

An Act authorizing the Retirement of State Employees upon the Expiration of Thirty Years of Service.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Paragraph (5) of section two of chapter thirty-two
2 of the General Laws, as appearing in the Tercente-
3 nary Edition, is hereby amended by striking out, in
4 the first line of said paragraph, the word "thirty-
5 five" and inserting in place thereof the word:—
6 thirty, — so as to read as follows:— (5) Any mem-
7 ber who has completed a period of thirty years of
8 continuous service may retire, or may be retired at
9 any age by the board upon recommendation of the
10 head of the department in which he is employed, if
11 such action be deemed advisable for the good of the
12 service.
