

SENATE No. 222

To accompany the petition of Thomas M. Burke that officers and members of the police force of the Metropolitan District Commission be excused from supervision of work other than police work. Metropolitan Affairs.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Thirty-Six.

An Act excusing Officers and Members of the Police Force of the Metropolitan District Commission from Supervision of Work Other than Police Work.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter ninety-two of the General Laws is
2 hereby amended by inserting after section sixty-
3 one, as appearing in the Tercentenary Edition,
4 the following new section: —

5 *Section 61A.* No officer or member of the police
6 force of the metropolitan district commission shall
7 be required to supervise the work of employees
8 other than police officers; but such supervision,
9 when necessary, shall be by duly qualified fore-
10 men or other appropriate persons holding super-
11 visory positions other than in said police force.
