

SENATE No. 285

To accompany the petition of Cornelius F. Haley that the Commonwealth acquire for recreational purposes Wingaersheek Beach, otherwise known as Coffin's Beach, in the city of Gloucester. Harbors and Public Lands.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Thirty-Six.

An Act providing for the Acquisition by the Commonwealth for Public Recreational Purposes of Wingaersheek Beach, otherwise known as Coffin's Beach, in the City of Gloucester.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The commissioner of conservation is hereby author-
2 ized and directed to purchase on behalf of the com-
3 monwealth, with the approval of the governor and
4 council, and subject to appropriation, one thousand
5 acres of land in the city of Gloucester, more or less,
6 known as Wingaersheek beach or Coffin's beach, and
7 to improve and administer the same for public recrea-
8 tional and conservation purposes under chapter one
9 hundred and thirty-two A of the General Laws, as
10 appearing in the Tercentenary Edition.
