## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Thirty-Six.

An Act relative to the Appointment and Tenure of Office  
of Assessors and Assistant Assessors.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Said chapter forty-one is hereby  
2 amended by striking out section twenty-five A and  
3 inserting in place thereof the following:—

4 *Section 25A.* The assessors may appoint such as-  
5 sistant assessors as they may deem necessary and may  
6 remove them.

1 SECTION 2. Section twenty-four A of said chapter  
2 forty-one is hereby repealed.

1 SECTION 3. All provisions of special acts relative  
2 to appointment and tenure of office of assistant as-  
3 sessors otherwise than as provided in said chapter  
4 forty-one as amended are hereby repealed.

1 SECTION 4. This act shall take effect as of January  
2 first, nineteen hundred and thirty-seven.
