## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Thirty-Seven.

An Act providing for the Laying Out and Construction of Scott Hill Road in the Town of Bellingham as a State Highway.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The department of public works,  
2 hereinafter called the department, is hereby au-  
3 thorized and directed to lay out and construct,  
4 as a state highway, Scott Hill road in the town  
5 of Bellingham, beginning at the junction of said  
6 road with route numbered one hundred and forty  
7 and extending to the Rhode Island-Massachu-  
8 setts state line.

1 SECTION 2. The department may, on behalf  
2 of the commonwealth, take by eminent domain  
3 under chapter seventy-nine of the General Laws,  
4 or acquire by purchase or otherwise, such public

5 or private lands, or parts thereof or rights therein,  
6 or public ways, as it may deem necessary for  
7 carrying out the provisions of section one, in-  
8 cluding such land or rights in land as may be  
9 necessary for the construction of any necessary  
10 drainage outlets; provided, that no damages  
11 shall be paid for public lands or public ways so  
12 taken.

1 SECTION 3. The cost of laying out and con-  
2 structing said state highway and the land tak-  
3 ings for the same, including any damages awarded  
4 or paid on account of any taking of land or  
5 property therefor, or any injury to the same, and  
6 any sums so paid for lands or rights purchased,  
7 including also all other expenses incurred in  
8 carrying out the provisions of section one, shall  
9 be deemed to be the cost of the work therein  
10 authorized.

1 SECTION 4. The entire cost of the work author-  
2 ized by section one shall be paid from such ap-  
3 propriation, not exceeding                   dollars, as  
4 may hereafter be made from the Highway Fund.
