

SENATE No. 177

To accompany the petition of Thomas H. Johnston that the Metropolitan District Commission be authorized and directed to provide for the completion of the diversion of the waters of East Waushacum Pond in the town of Sterling. Metropolitan Affairs.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Thirty-Seven.

An Act authorizing and directing the Metropolitan District Commission to provide for the Completion of the Diversion of the Waters of East Waushacum Pond in the Town of Sterling.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The metropolitan district commission
2 is hereby authorized and directed to provide for the
3 completion of the diversion of the waters of East
4 Waushacum pond in the town of Sterling, in accord-
5 ance with, and in supplement to, the terms and
6 provisions of section two of chapter three hundred
7 and forty-six of the acts of nineteen hundred and
8 thirty-four. For the purpose of completing the said
9 construction, said commission may expend, in addition
10 to the amount provided for in said section two, such
11 sums not exceeding, in the aggregate, ten thousand
12 dollars, as may hereafter be appropriated therefor.

13 The sums so expended shall be added to the annual
14 assessments upon the cities and towns comprising
15 the metropolitan water district, and apportioned and
16 collected as provided by section twenty-six of chapter
17 ninety-two of the General Laws. Such funds may
18 be used in conjunction with federal money granted for
19 the purpose of completing said diversion.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
