

SENATE No. 245

To accompany the petition of George E. Dalrymple, mayor, and members of the board of aldermen, for legislation relative to the appointment of a city solicitor in the city of Haverhill. Cities.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Thirty-Seven.

An Act relative to the Appointment of a City Solicitor
in the City of Haverhill.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The mayor shall annually, as soon
2 after the organization of the municipal council as
3 may be convenient, without the approval of the
4 municipal council, appoint a city solicitor, who shall
5 hold his office for the term of one year and until his
6 successor shall be appointed and qualified. The
7 city solicitor so appointed may be removed at any
8 time by the mayor.

1 SECTION 2. Section fourteen of statute eighteen
2 hundred and sixty-nine, chapter sixty-one; sections
3 nineteen, twenty-six, twenty-seven and thirty-one of
4 chapter five hundred and seventy-four of the acts of
5 the year nineteen hundred and eight, and all other
6 acts and parts of acts inconsistent herewith are hereby
7 repealed.
