Resolve providing for an Investigation by the Department of Public Health relative to the Establishment and Maintenance of an Institution for the Care and Treatment of Persons residing in the Counties of Essex and Middlesex suffering from Cancer.

1 *Resolved*, That the department of public health is
2 hereby authorized and directed to investigate the
3 subject matter of current senate document numbered
4 one hundred and thirty-six, relative to the establish-
5 ment and maintenance in the county of Essex or the
6 county of Middlesex of an institution for the care
7 and treatment of certain persons suffering from
8 cancer. Said department shall report to the general
9 court the results of its investigation and its recom-
10 mendations, if any, together with estimates of cost
11 and drafts of legislation necessary to carry such recom-
12 mendations into effect, by filing the same with the
13 clerk of the senate on or before the first Wednesday
14 of December in the current year.
