To accompany the petition of Arthur F. Blanchard that the sale of used motor vehicles be further regulated. Highways and Motor Vehicles.

AN ACT FURTHER REGULATING THE SALE OF USED MOTOR VEHICLES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter ninety of the General Laws is hereby
2 amended by inserting after section thirty-two F,
3 inserted therein by section one of chapter two hundred
4 and nine of the acts of nineteen hundred and thirty-
5 four, the following new section:—

6 *Section 32G.* At or before the time of the transfer,
7 by sale or otherwise, of a used motor vehicle and
8 before such motor vehicle is registered by or for the
9 purchaser thereof, the vendor of such motor vehicle
10 shall execute in duplicate a statement under oath
11 setting forth in detail all repairs to, alterations of
12 and additional parts or other equipment furnished to
13 such motor vehicle within the preceding ninety days
14 by him or it, together with the date when such work
15 was done or parts or equipment furnished. One copy

16 of such statement shall be filed with the registrar of
17 motor vehicles at the time of the transfer of registra-
18 tion of such motor vehicle and the other copy shall
19 be given to the purchaser at or before the time when
20 title passes. Whoever violates any provision of this
21 section shall be punished by .
