AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE EQUAL SHARING OF MILK SALES
BY PRODUCER DEALERS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter three hundred and seventy-six, acts of
2 nineteen hundred and thirty-four, as amended by
3 chapter three hundred, acts of nineteen hundred and
4 thirty-six, and chapter four hundred and twenty-
5 eight, acts of nineteen hundred and thirty-seven, is
6 hereby amended by inserting at the end of paragraph
7 B, section fifteen:—

8 *Section 15B.* Each such order shall provide rules
9 and regulations for the sharing of Class One and
10 Class Two sales of milk on an equal basis between
11 producer-dealers and such producers from whom milk
12 is purchased provided that such producer-dealer buys
13 more than ten per cent of his fluid milk sales from
14 producers during any pay period.
