RESOLVE IN FAVOR OF GRACE L. KING OF SANDWICH.

1 *Resolved*, That, for the purpose of discharging the
2 moral obligation of the commonwealth in the prem-
3 ises and subject to appropriation, there be allowed
4 and paid from the treasury of the commonwealth to
5 Grace L. King of Sandwich, whose husband, Gordon
6 King, died May first of the current year in conse-
7 quence of injuries sustained on April twenty-seventh
8 of the current year while fighting a forest fire at the
9 Shawme state forest, an annuity of dollars,
10 payable in equal monthly instalments, so long as she
11 does not remarry, but for a period not longer than
12 five years. No payment shall be made hereunder
13 until there shall have been filed with the state treas-
14 urer an agreement signed by said Grace L. King
15 that the amount, if any, to be paid for legal services
16 rendered in connection with the passage of this re-
17 solve shall not exceed ten per cent of the amounts
18 paid hereunder.
