AN ACT MAKING CERTAIN PERSONS SIXTY YEARS OF AGE
OR OVER ELIGIBLE FOR OLD AGE ASSISTANCE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section one of chapter one hundred and eighteen A
2 of the General Laws, as appearing in section one of
3 chapter four hundred and thirty-six of the acts of
4 nineteen hundred and thirty-six, is hereby amended
5 by striking out the word "sixty-five" wherever it
6 appears therein and inserting in place thereof the
7 word: — sixty.
