RESOLVE VALIDATING CERTAIN ACTS OF VIRGINIA B. SMITH, FORMERLY VIRGINIA B. WALKER, OF FALMOUTH, AS NOTARY PUBLIC.

1 *Resolved*, That the acts of Virginia B. Smith of
2 Falmouth as a notary public under her maiden name
3 of Virginia B. Walker, between May thirtieth, nine-
4 teen hundred and thirty-seven and September ninth,
5 nineteen hundred and thirty-eight, both dates inclu-
6 sive, in so far as the same may have been invalid by
7 reason of the fact that, upon the change of her name
8 from Virginia B. Walker, she failed to re-register under
9 her new name as required by section thirteen of chap-
10 ter thirty of the General Laws, are hereby confirmed
11 and made valid.
