AN ACT PROHIBITING THE REQUIRING OF CERTAIN INFORMATION CONCERNING VIOLATIONS OF MOTOR VEHICLE PARKING LAWS IN APPLICATIONS FOR CIVIL SERVICE EXAMINATIONS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Chapter thirty-one of the General Laws is hereby  
2 amended by inserting after section six A, inserted by  
3 chapter two hundred and twenty-eight of the acts of  
4 nineteen hundred and thirty-five, the following new  
5 section: —

6 *Section 6B.* No applicant for appointment to any  
7 office or position subject to this chapter shall be re-  
8 quired to state a record of conviction of a violation  
9 of any provision of any rule, regulation, order, ordi-  
10 nance or by-law regulating the parking of motor  
11 vehicles established by any city or town or by any  
12 commission or body empowered by law to make such  
13 rules or regulations therein.
