To accompany the petition of George F. Cunningham and another that provision be made for the appointment of Augustine J. Walsh, John P. Harrington, Harold W. Tynning, George F. Cunningham and John J. Roche as permanent police officers in the town of North Andover. Civil Service.

AN ACT PROVIDING FOR THE APPOINTMENT OF AUGUSTINE J. WALSH, JOHN P. HARRINGTON, HAROLD W. TYNING, GEORGE F. CUNNINGHAM AND JOHN J. ROCHE AS PERMANENT RESERVE POLICE OFFICERS IN THE TOWN OF NORTH ANDOVER.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Upon the effective date of this act,
2 Augustine J. Walsh, John P. Harrington, Harold J.
3 Tynning, George F. Cunningham, John J. Roche, duly
4 elected constables of the town of North Andover, shall
5 become permanent reserve police officers of said town,
6 without taking a civil service examination.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall be submitted for ac-
2 ceptance to the voters of said town at the annual
3 town election in the current year in the form of the
4 following question which shall be placed upon the

5 official ballot to be used at said election:—“Shall
6 an act passed by the general court in the year nine-
7 teen hundred and thirty-nine, entitled ‘An act pro-
8 viding for the appointment of Augustine J. Walsh,
9 John P. Harrington, Harold W. Tynning, George F.
10 Cunningham and John J. Roche as permanent re-
11 serve police officers in the town of North Andover’,
12 be accepted?” If a majority of the votes in answer
13 to said question is in the affirmative, then this act
14 shall thereupon take full effect.
