To accompany the petition of George M. DeVoe for legislation relative to the use of certain election districts in the city of Cambridge. Election Laws.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Thirty-Nine.

AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE USE OF CERTAIN ELECTION DISTRICTS IN THE CITY OF CAMBRIDGE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The wards established in the city of
2 Cambridge in the year nineteen hundred and thirty-
3 four as authorized by chapter one hundred of the
4 acts of nineteen hundred and twenty-two, shall be
5 used for all municipal primaries and elections held in
6 said city, and for such purposes election officers shall
7 be appointed and voting lists shall be prepared and
8 all other things required by law pertaining to such
9 primaries and elections shall be done in accordance
10 with the lines of the wards so established, any pro-
11 vision of general or special law to the contrary not-
12 withstanding.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
