To accompany the petition of the Disabled American Veterans of the World War, Department of Massachusetts, by Joseph H. Gillis, adjutant, for legislation to further regulate the application of certain retirement laws to certain veterans. Pensions and Municipal Finance (sitting jointly).

AN ACT FURTHER REGULATING THE APPLICATION OF
CERTAIN RETIREMENT LAWS TO CERTAIN VETERANS.

1 *Whereas*, The deferred operation of this act would
2 tend to defeat its purpose, therefore it is hereby
3 declared to be an emergency law, necessary for the
4 immediate preservation of the public convenience.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The last paragraph of section sixty of
2 chapter thirty-two of the General Laws, as most
3 recently amended by section one of chapter four
4 hundred and fifty-two of the acts of nineteen hundred
5 and thirty-eight, is hereby further amended by
6 striking out, in the second line of said paragraph, the
7 word "thirty-nine" and inserting in place thereof the
8 word:—forty-four,—so that said paragraph will
9 read as follows:—No veteran whose employment
10 first began after June thirtieth, nineteen hundred and

11 forty-four, shall be subject to the provisions of sec-
12 tions fifty-six to fifty-nine, inclusive.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall apply to all veterans
2 whose employment first began after June thirtieth
3 nineteen hundred and thirty-seven.
