

SENATE No. 306

To accompany the petition of Thomas J. Lane, William J. Casey and Cornelius J. Twomey that provision be made for the abolition of the underpass in Osgood Street in the city of Lawrence and for the restoration of the grade crossing as formerly existed at said place. Highways and Motor Vehicles.

AN ACT PROVIDING FOR THE ABOLITION OF THE UNDERPASS IN OSGOOD STREET IN THE CITY OF LAWRENCE AND FOR THE RESTORATION OF THE GRADE CROSSING FORMERLY EXISTING AT SAID PLACE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The department of public works, for
2 the security and convenience of the public, is hereby
3 authorized and directed to abolish the underpass
4 now existing under the tracks of the Boston and Maine
5 Railroad in Osgood street in the city of Lawrence and
6 to restore the grade crossing at said place as it existed
7 prior to construction of such underpass. Said depart-
8 ment shall determine the manner and limits of said
9 crossing, what part, if any, of any public or private
10 way shall be discontinued or constructed, and, after
11 hearing, the changes to be made in the location and
12 grades of such railroad, and what land or property

13 it considers necessary to be taken, including any
14 easement in any land.

1 SECTION 2. The total cost of such work shall be
2 paid from the Highway Fund.

1 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
