The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Thirty-Nine.

AN ACT PROVIDING THAT ALL MEETINGS OF THE EXECUTIVE COUNCIL BE OPEN TO THE PUBLIC.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter six of the General Laws is hereby amended
2 by inserting after section four, as appearing in the
3 Tercentenary Edition, the following new section:—
4 *Section 4A.* The general public shall not be ex-
5 cluded from the room or from any place in which the
6 governor shall hold or keep a council as provided
7 by Article I of section eleven of chapter eleven of the
8 constitution.
