AN ACT PROVIDING FOR THE LANDSCAPING AS A PARK RESERVATION OF BOTH SIDES OF THE BOSTON CENTRAL ARTERY, KNOWN AND DESIGNATED AS THE JOHN F. FITZGERALD EXPRESSWAY, BEGINNING AT CHARLES STREET CIRCLE AT THE FOOT OF LEVERETT STREET.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The department of public works is hereby author-
2 ized and directed to landscape as a park reservation,
3 with lawns, trees and flowers, the land belonging to
4 the commonwealth on both sides of the Boston cen-
5 tral artery, known and designated as the John F.
6 Fitzgerald Expressway, beginning at Charles street
7 circle at the foot of Leverett street, and to construct
8 thereon suitable benches and water fountains. For
9 said purposes said department may expend such sums
10 as may hereafter be appropriated therefor.
