RESOLVE PROVIDING FOR AN INVESTIGATION AND STUDY OF THE FEASIBILITY OF PARTIAL FINANCIAL PARTICIPATION BY THE COMMONWEALTH IN CERTAIN FORMS OF GROUP INSURANCE FOR EMPLOYEES OF THE COMMONWEALTH AND THEIR DEPENDENTS.

1 *Resolved*, That the special unpaid commission,
2 established under the provisions of chapter five
3 hundred and sixteen of the acts of nineteen hundred
4 and fifty-one, to provide certain insurance protection
5 for state employees and their dependents, is hereby
6 authorized and directed to investigate and study the
7 feasibility of partial financial participation by the
8 commonwealth in group hospital, medical, surgical,
9 accident and life insurance coverage for state em-
10 ployees and their dependents and the extent of such
11 financial participation by the commonwealth. Said
12 commission may expend for the purpose of this
13 resolve such sums as may be appropriated therefor,
14 not exceeding twenty-five hundred dollars. Said
15 commission shall report to the general court the

16 results of its study and investigation, and its recom-
17 mendations, if any, together with drafts of legislation
18 necessary to carry such recommendations into effect,
19 by filing the same with the clerk of the house of
20 representatives on or before the first Wednesday of
21 December in the current year.
