AN ACT RELATIVE TO APPROPRIATIONS BY THE TOWN OF CHATHAM FOR MUNICIPAL ADVERTISING PURPOSES AND FOR PUBLIC AMUSEMENTS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The town of Chatham may, by a  
2 majority vote, appropriate each year a sum not ex-  
3 ceeding twenty-five hundred dollars for advertising  
4 the advantages of the town and for providing amuse-  
5 ments or entertainments of a public character. The  
6 money so appropriated by the town shall be expended  
7 under the direction of the selectmen.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its  
2 passage.
