## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Fifty-Three.

### AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE DISTRIBUTION OF PASTERS OR STICKERS AT POLLING PLACES.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section 65 of chapter 54 of the General Laws is  
2 hereby amended by striking out the second sentence,  
3 as appearing in section 15 of chapter 411 of the acts  
4 of 1943, and chapter 129 of the acts of 1952 and in-  
5 serting in place thereof the following:—Pasters,  
6 commonly called stickers, shall not be posted in the  
7 polling place, in the building where the polling place  
8 is located, on the walls thereof, on the premises on  
9 which the building stands, on the sidewalk adjoining  
10 the premises where such election is being held, or  
11 within one hundred and fifty feet of the entrance to  
12 such polling place. Such pasters or stickers shall not  
13 be distributed within one hundred and fifty feet of  
14 the polling place.
