### AN ACT TO ABOLISH ALL SPECIAL AUTOMOBILE PARKING PRIVILEGES OF MEMBERS OF THE GENERAL COURT.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any provision of gen-  
2 eral or special law to the contrary, no member of the  
3 general court shall be entitled to any special privilege  
4 or preference in so far as the parking of motor vehicles  
5 is concerned on any public way or place beyond that  
6 accorded to all citizens.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its  
2 passage.
