AN ACT PERMITTING WILLIAM REED OF BOSTON TO SUE
THE COMMONWEALTH IN THE SUPERIOR COURT IN TORT.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the
same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. William Reed of Boston is hereby
2 granted permission to sue the commonwealth in the
3 superior court in tort for damages for injuries received
4 while an inmate of a state institution and for ex-
5 penses of hospital and medical care incurred by him
6 on account of said injuries.

1 SECTION 2. For the purposes of this suit by Wil-
2 liam Reed against the commonwealth, the period of
3 limitations will not start to run until the date upon
4 which this bill is passed by the general court.
