By Mr. Seibelli of Springfield, petition of Daniel B. Brunton (mayor) (by vote of the city council) that the city of Springfield be authorized to sell certain park land in said city. Cities.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Fifty-Three.

AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF SPRINGFIELD TO SELL OR OTHERWISE DISPOSE OF CERTAIN LAND SITUATED IN SAID CITY.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The city of Springfield, acting by and through its
2 mayor and its board of park commissioners, may, by
3 sale, exchange or otherwise, transfer and dispose of
4 certain real property situated in said city and form-
5 erly conveyed to it by Nellie R. Sullivan for park
6 purposes, said property being bounded and described
7 as follows: — Beginning at an iron pin at the north-
8 westerly corner of Millbrook road and Grand Valley
9 road; thence north on land now or formerly of Mar-
10 garet E. Ganley, trustee for Nellie R. Sullivan, five
11 hundred fifty-eight and 10/100 (558.10) feet to a stake
12 and nail; thence north two hundred and 48/100
13 (200.48) feet on a curve to the left of seven hundred
14 forty-four and 08/100 (744.08) feet radius to a stake
15 and nail; thence north one hundred ninety-nine and

16 07/100 (199.07) feet on a curve to the right eight
17 hundred forty and 47/100 (840.47) feet radius to a
18 stake and nail; thence north two hundred fifty-four
19 and 28/100 (254.28) feet on a curve to the right of
20 nine hundred forty-six and 29/100 (946.29) feet
21 radius to a stake and nail; thence north six hundred
22 ninety-six and 99/100 (696.99) feet on a curve to the
23 left of nine hundred fifty-two and 81/100 (952.81)
24 feet radius to a stake and nail; thence north one
25 hundred ninety-eight and 54/100 (198.54) feet on a
26 curve to the right of three hundred fifty-four and 8/10
27 (354.8) feet radius to a stake and nail; thence north
28 eighty and 63/100 (80.63) feet to land of Frederick
29 Kattler (later of one Thyberg); thence easterly on
30 said land formerly of Kattler four hundred (400)
31 feet more or less to the center line of the south branch
32 of Mill river; thence south by the southerly line of
33 said south branch of Mill river to the north line of
34 Millbrook road extended easterly; thence westerly
35 two hundred seventy (270) feet more or less on land
36 now or formerly of the heirs of Eben J. P. Sullivan, to
37 the place of beginning, being the same premises de-
38 scribed in a deed from Nellie R. Sullivan to the city
39 of Springfield dated July thirteenth, nineteen hundred
40 and twenty-eight, and recorded in Hampden County
41 Registry of Deeds in Book 1702, page 173.
