AN ACT LIMITING THE AUTHORITY OF THE ATTORNEY GENERAL IN ASSUMING THE DUTIES OF A DISTRICT ATTORNEY.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Section 27 of chapter 12 of the General Laws, as
- 2 appearing in the Tercentenary Edition, is hereby
- 3 amended by adding at the end thereof the following
- 4 sentence: But the attorney general shall not assume
- 5 the duties of the district attorney in any district over
- 6 the objections of such district attorney prior to peti-
- 7 tioning the supreme judicial court for authority to
- 8 assume such duties. Such authority shall be granted
- 9 by the supreme judicial court only after it has issued
- 10 a citation to such district attorney to show cause why
- 11 the petition shall not be allowed and after a hearing
- If the petition shall not be allowed and after a hearing 12 on such citation.
