AN ACT FURTHER REGULATING THE PROMOTION OF CIVIL SERVICE EMPLOYEES IN THE LABOR SERVICE SUBJECT TO THE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF CIVIL SERVICE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 15B of chapter 31 of the General Laws is
2 hereby amended by inserting after the word "depart-
3 ment" in line 3, the following: — or division of a de-
4 partment, — and by inserting after the word "de-
5 partment" in line 4, the words: — or division of a
6 department, — and by inserting after the word "de-
7 partment" in line 5, the following: — or division of
8 a department, — so as to read: — *Section 15B.* An
9 appointing official, with the approval of the director,
10 may promote to the lowest grade in the official service
11 of a department, or division of a department, board
12 or commission employees in the labor service of the
13 same department, or division of a department, board

14 or commission who pass a competitive promotional
15 examination open to all the employees in said labor
16 service of said department, or division of a depart-
17 ment, board or commission who have been employed
18 therein for at least one year.
