AN ACT PLACING CERTAIN EMPLOYEES OF THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS UNDER THE CIVIL SERVICE LAWS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 The positions of persons employed in speed control  
2 unit of the traffic division of the department of public  
3 works shall, upon the effective date of this act, be  
4 come subject to the civil service laws and rules. The  
5 incumbent of every such position on said effective  
6 date shall be subjected to a qualifying examination  
7 for such position by the division of civil service. If  
8 such an incumbent passes said examination, he shall  
9 be certified for said position and shall be deemed to  
10 be permanently appointed thereto without serving  
11 any probationary period, and his tenure of office, as  
12 well as the tenure of office of any subsequent incum-  
13 bent of said position, shall be unlimited, subject, how-  
14 ever, to the provisions of said civil service laws and  
15 rules. If such an incumbent does not pass said quali-  
16 fying examination, he may continue to serve in said  
17 position, but shall not be subject to the provisions of  
18 said civil service laws and rules.
