AN ACT MAKING THE PROVISIONS OF THE CIVIL SERVICE LAWS APPLICABLE TO THE TOWN OF HULL WITH RESPECT TO CERTAIN TOWN EMPLOYEES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The positions of foreman playground
2 commission; maintenance man fire department; cus-
3 todians public buildings; custodians school depart-
4 ment; laborers tree department; caretaker cemetery;
5 and foreman garbage disposal shall, upon the effective
6 date of this act, become subject to the civil service
7 laws and rules, and the tenure of the incumbents
8 thereof shall be unlimited, subject, however, to said
9 laws; but the present incumbents of said positions
10 shall continue to serve as such without taking a civil
11 service examination.

1 SECTION 2. The provisions of this act shall take
2 full effect upon its acceptance by the town meeting
3 members at the annual town meeting in the year
4 nineteen hundred and fifty-three, but not otherwise.
