RESOLVE PROVIDING FOR AN INVESTIGATION AND STUDY BY A SPECIAL COMMISSION OF THE MATTER OF REQUIRING HUNTERS TO CARRY INSURANCE TO REIMBURSE THOSE SUSTAINING PERSONAL INJURIES OR PROPERTY DAMAGE AS A RESULT OF THEIR NEGLIGENCE.

1 *Resolved*, That an unpaid special commission, to  
2 consist of two members of the senate to be designated  
3 by the president of the senate, three members of the  
4 house of representatives to be designated by the  
5 speaker thereof and two persons to be appointed  
6 by the governor with the advice and consent of the  
7 council, is hereby established for the purpose of  
8 making an investigation and study of the matter of  
9 requiring hunters to carry insurance to reimburse  
10 those sustaining personal injuries and property dam-  
11 age as a result of the negligence of said hunters. Said  
12 commission shall report to the general court the  
13 results of its investigation and study and its recom-  
14 mendations, if any, together with drafts of legislation  
15 necessary to carry such recommendations into effect,  
16 by filing the same with the clerk of the house of  
17 representatives on or before the first Wednesday of  
18 December in the current year.
