In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Fifty-Three.

AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE TOWN OF WRENTHAM TO SUPPLY AND SELL WATER TO THE TOWN OF NORFOLK.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- The town of Wrentham may supply and sell water
- 2 for domestic and other purposes to the town of
- 3 Norfolk upon such terms and conditions as may be
- 4 agreed upon between said towns, or, in case of failure
- 5 so to agree, upon such terms and conditions as may
- 6 be fixed by the department of public utilities; and
- 7 said town of Norfolk is hereby authorized to purchase
- 8 such water. Any installation and extension of water
- 9 mains and other facilities made within the limits of
- 10 the town of Norfolk shall be subject in all respects
- 11 to the approval of the selectmen of said town.
