

HOUSE No. 1528

By Mr. Tyler of Watertown, petition of George Fingold that the game commonly known as "skillo" and similar games be considered to be lotteries. Legal Affairs.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Fifty-Three.

AN ACT PROVIDING THAT THE GAME COMMONLY KNOWN AS SKILLO, AND SIMILAR GAMES, CONSTITUTE LOTTERIES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Chapter 271 of the General Laws is hereby amended
- 2 by inserting after section 6A the following section:—
- 3 *Section 6B.* Whoever sets up or promotes the game
- 4 commonly known as skillo or any similar game re-
- 5 gardless of name, shall be held to have set up and
- 6 promoted a lottery, and shall be punished as provided
- 7 in section seven.
