AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE DELIVERY OF BAKERY PRODUCTS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Chapter 94 of the General Laws is hereby amended
- 2 by inserting after section 4 the following section:—
- 3 *Section 4A.* No bakery product shall be removed
- 4 from a bakery for delivery to a restaurant or dealer
- 5 unless the same is packaged or wrapped. Whoever
- 6 violates the provisions of this act shall be punished
- 7 by a fine of not less than fifty nor more than one
- 8 hundred dollars, or by imprisonment for not more
- 9 than ten days.
