AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE USE OF THE WORDS "ARMY AND NAVY" IN THE TRADE NAME AND BUSINESS OF GERALD D. MICHELMAN.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Notwithstanding the provisions of section four B  
2 of chapter one hundred and ten of the General Laws  
3 to the contrary, Gerald D. Michelman of Springfield,  
4 a disabled veteran, may use the words "army and  
5 navy" in the trade name of his business or in the  
6 description of himself or the place where he might  
7 sell, or offer for sale, goods, wares or merchandise.
