AN ACT ESTABLISHING THE METROPOLITAN DISTRICT COMMISSION ADVISORY COUNCIL.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Chapter 28 of the General Laws is hereby amended
2 by adding after section 3 thereof the following new
3 section: —
- 4 *Section 3A.* There shall be in the commission an
5 advisory board to be known as the metropolitan dis-
6 trict commission advisory council, consisting of one
7 member from each city and town in the metropolitan
8 district to be designated from time to time by the re-
9 spective mayors and boards of selectmen of said cities
10 and towns. The commissioner shall act as chairman
11 of the council which will meet at least once each month
12 and on such other occasions as meetings may be called
13 by the commissioner. The commissioner shall advise
14 the council of plans of the commission affecting the
15 district and the council shall act in an advisory capac-

16 ity to the commissioner. The members of the coun-
17 cil shall serve without compensation but shall be re-
18 imbursed for their actual necessary expenses incurred
19 in the performance of their duties. The commissioner
20 shall cause minutes of all meetings of the council to be
21 kept which shall be public records.
