AN ACT RELATIVE TO SAFETY DEVICES ON ELEVATORS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any provisions of
2 law to the contrary, all means of ingress or egress to
3 any commercial indoor passenger or freight elevator
4 now in operation or to be constructed or installed
5 throughout the commonwealth hereafter shall be by
6 a door that shall cover the entire opening between the
7 elevator and the area into which it enters; said door
8 shall be equipped with a device which will prevent it
9 from being opened unless the floor of the elevator is
10 on an approximate level with the bottom of the door,
11 and a device that will prevent the door from being
12 opened or closed while the elevator is in motion.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect on January
2 first, nineteen hundred and fifty six.
