

HOUSE No. 1642

By Mr. Harding of Dedham, petition of Francis A. Harding for legislation to increase the salaries of certain employees at the Massachusetts Hospital School for Crippled Children. Public Service.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

AN ACT RAISING THE SALARY OF CERTAIN EMPLOYEES AT THE MASSACHUSETTS HOSPITAL SCHOOL FOR CRIP- PLED CHILDREN.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The position of "institutional school
2 teacher" in the Massachusetts Hospital School for
3 Crippled Children is hereby changed to "teacher of
4 orthopedically handicapped children." All persons
5 now employed in the position of "institutional school
6 teacher" in said school shall be classified as "teacher
7 of orthopedically handicapped children." The salary
8 range of teachers of orthopedically handicapped chil-
9 dren is hereby established at a minimum of thirty-one
10 hundred and eighty dollars annually to a maximum of
11 thirty-seven hundred and eighty dollars annually.

1 SECTION 2. The position of "principal of the
2 Massachusetts Hospital School for Crippled Children"
3 is hereby changed to "principal and supervisor of

4 teachers of orthopedically handicapped children.”
5 The present incumbent of the position of “principal
6 of the Massachusetts State Hospital School for
7 Crippled Children” at said school shall hereby be
8 classified as “principal and supervisor of teachers of
9 orthopedically handicapped children.” The salary
10 range is hereby established at a minimum of forty-
11 three hundred and eighty dollars annually to a maxi-
12 mum of fifty-two hundred and eighty dollars annually.
