AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE SALARY OF THE MAYOR OF WESTFIELD.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 11 of chapter 294 of the acts
2 of 1920 is hereby amended by striking out the first
3 sentence and inserting in place thereof the following: —
4 The mayor, commencing January first, nineteen
5 hundred and fifty-four, shall receive for his services
6 the sum of five thousand dollars a year, and he shall
7 receive no other compensation from the city.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall be submitted for ac-
2 ceptance to the registered voters of the city of West-
3 field at the regular municipal election in the year
4 nineteen hundred and fifty-three, in the form of the
5 following question, which shall be placed upon the
6 official ballot to be used at said election: — “Shall an
7 act passed by the general court in the current year,

8 providing that the mayor of this city, commencing
9 January first, nineteen hundred and fifty-four, shall
10 receive for his services the sum of five thousand dollars
11 a year, be accepted?" If a majority of the votes in
12 answer to said question is in the affirmative, this act
13 shall take full effect, but not otherwise.
