RESOLUTIONS MEMORIALIZING THE CONGRESS TO ACCEPT CERTAIN RECOMMENDATIONS CONTAINED IN THE REPORT OF THE HOOVER COMMISSION.

Resolved, That the general court of Massachusetts hereby urges the Congress of the United States to accept the balance of the recommendations contained in the report of the Hoover commission as a means of curtailing inflation; and be it further

Resolved, That copies of these resolutions be sent forthwith by the secretary of the commonwealth to the President of the United States, to the presiding officer of each branch of Congress, and to the members thereof from this commonwealth.
