

HOUSE No. 1861

By Mr. Harding of Dedham, petition of Francis A. Harding that cities and towns be authorized to prohibit the use of state highways within their limits by commercial motor vehicles whenever such action is deemed necessary to promote public safety. Highways and Motor Vehicles.

AN ACT AUTHORIZING ANY CITY OR TOWN TO PROHIBIT THE USE OF ANY STATE HIGHWAY WITHIN ITS LIMITS BY COMMERCIAL MOTOR VEHICLES WHEN DEEMED TO BE NECESSARY TO PROMOTE PUBLIC SAFETY.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Any city or town is hereby authorized to prohibit
- 2 the use of any state highway within the limits of such
- 3 city or town by commercial motor vehicles whenever
- 4 such action is deemed to be necessary to promote
- 5 public safety.
