By Mr. Kelleher of Marlborough, petition of Charles T. Kelleher that the Department of Public Works be authorized to install traffic control signals at the intersection of Bolton and Main Streets in the city of Marlborough. Highways and Motor Vehicles.

AN ACT PROVIDING FOR THE INSTALLATION OF TRAFFIC CONTROL SIGNALS BY THE STATE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS IN THE CITY OF MARLBOROUGH.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The state department of public works is hereby
2 authorized and directed to install in the city of Marl-
3 borough pre-timed traffic control signals at the inter-
4 section of Bolton and Main streets, which shall include
5 Main and Howe streets with a connection to the
6 Central fire station located at the northwesterly corner
7 of Bolton and Main streets, all in accordance with
8 recommendations made by the said department in
9 a letter to Marlborough traffic commission, dated
10 May five, nineteen hundred and fifty.
