### RESOLVE FOR THE ESTABLISHMENT OF A COMMISSION TO STUDY RATES OF INSURANCE.

1 *Resolved*, That there shall be established a commis-  
2 sion to investigate the rates of insurance as they relate  
3 to personal property, homes, households, individuals  
4 and small businesses.

5 Said commission shall consist of seven members,  
6 two of whom shall be members of the senate and desig-  
7 nated by the president of the senate; three to be  
8 members of the house of representatives and desig-  
9 nated by the speaker of the house of representatives;  
10 and two to be designated by his excellency the gov-  
11 ernor.

12 Said commission shall select the chairman from its  
13 membership and appoint a secretary.

14 For the purpose of this resolve, the said commis-  
15 sion may expend such sum as may be appropriated  
16 by the general court in the year nineteen hundred and  
17 fifty-three.
