AN ACT MAKING THE STATE AUDITOR A MEMBER OF THE TRUSTEES OF THE METROPOLITAN TRANSIT AUTHORITY BY VIRTUE OF HIS OFFICE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 2 of chapter 544 of the acts of 1947 is hereby
2 amended by striking out the first sentence and insert-
3 ing in place thereof the following sentence:— The
4 affairs of the authority shall be managed by a board
5 of five public trustees, hereinafter in this act called the
6 trustees, one of whom shall be the state auditor, and
7 four who shall be appointed by the governor with the
8 advice and consent of the council. Said term of the
9 state auditor shall begin at the expiration of the term
10 of the next outgoing trustee.
