AN ACT ON BEHALF OF DISABLED VETERANS OF WORLD WAR II.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Notwithstanding the provisions of the General
2 Laws or any special acts thereof, all veterans of
3 World War II who are receiving fifty per cent dis-
4 ability payments from the federal government as the
5 result of war-connected disabilities are hereby
6 exempted from the payment of any or all license and
7 registration fees to the commonwealth for the receipt
8 of all said licenses or permits the commonwealth is
9 empowered to authorize; provided, that said veterans
10 are otherwise qualified to receive such licenses or
11 permits.
