By Mr. Tivnan of Worcester, petition of Andrew B. Holmstrom (mayor), Francis J. McGrath (city manager) (with the approval of the city council) that the city of Worcester be authorized to borrow additional money for industrial school purposes. Municipal Finance.

AN ACT PROVIDING FOR ADDITIONAL AUTHORITY FOR THE CITY OF WORCESTER TO BORROW MONEY FOR INDUSTRIAL SCHOOL PURPOSES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 1 of chapter 273 of the acts
2 of 1952 is hereby amended by striking out, in line 7,
3 the words "the westerly side of", — so as to read as
4 follows: — *Section 1.* The city of Worcester may
5 borrow from time to time, within a period of five
6 years from the passage of this act, such sums as may
7 be necessary, not exceeding, in the aggregate, nine
8 hundred thousand dollars for the purpose of acquiring
9 any necessary land by purchase or eminent domain,
10 and for constructing a school building or buildings
11 on land on Prescott street in said city, including the
12 cost of any surveys, architectural and engineering
13 services, and landscaping and originally equipping
14 and furnishing said school building or buildings, and

15 may issue bonds or notes therefor which shall bear
16 on their face the words, "Worcester Industrial School
17 Building Loan, Act of 1952."

18 Each authorized issue shall constitute a separate
19 loan, and such loans shall be payable in not more
20 than twenty years from their dates. Indebtedness
21 incurred under this act shall be in excess of the statu-
22 tory limit provided by chapter forty-four of the
23 General Laws, but shall, except as provided herein,
24 be subject to the provisions of said chapter forty-four,
25 excluding the limitation contained in the first para-
26 graph of section seven thereof, and shall be in excess
27 of the amount authorized by chapter two hundred
28 and eleven of the special acts of nineteen hundred
29 and sixteen, as amended by chapter one hundred and
30 thirty-eight of the acts of nineteen hundred and
31 twenty.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
