By Mr. Williams of Concord, petition of David B. Williams and another relative to the nomination of beneficiaries under option "C" of the contributory retirement law for public employees. Pensions and Old Age Assistance.

AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE NOMINATION OF BENEFICIARIES UNDER OPTION "C" OF THE LAW RELATIVE TO CONTRIBUTORY RETIREMENT OF PUBLIC EMPLOYEES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Option (C) of subdivision 2 of section 12 of chapter
2 32 of the General Laws, as appearing in chapter 618
3 of the acts of 1949, is hereby amended by inserting
4 after the word "sister", in the last line, the words: —
5 or brother, — so that the last paragraph will read as
6 follows: — No person shall be eligible for nomination
7 as beneficiary under this option unless such person is
8 the spouse, child, father, mother, or is the unmarried,
9 widowed, or divorced sister or brother of such member.
