RESOLVE PROVIDING FOR AN INVESTIGATION BY THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC HEALTH RELATIVE TO THE BRIGHTON ABATTOIR, SO CALLED, IN THE BRIGHTON DISTRICT OF THE CITY OF BOSTON.

1 *Resolved*, That the department of public health is
2 hereby authorized and directed to make an investi-
3 gation of the Brighton abattoir, so called, and the
4 immediate and surrounding area, in the Brighton dis-
5 trict of the city of Boston, with a view to determining
6 whether the use of said abattoir and the immediate
7 and surrounding area is causing any unsanitary con-
8 dition, pollution or nuisance. Said department shall
9 report to the general court the results of its investiga-
10 tion and its recommendations, if any, together with
11 drafts of legislation necessary to carry its recom-
12 mendations into effect, by filing the same with the
13 clerk of the house of representatives on or before the
14 first Wednesday of December in the current year.
