AN ACT REGULATING THE DISPOSAL OF CONTAINERS USED FOR REFRIGERATIVE PURPOSES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 271 of the General Laws is hereby amended
2 by inserting after section 45 the following section:—
3 *Section 46.* Whoever, having been the owner of a
4 container originally used for refrigerative purposes,
5 fails to remove the door or doors from the same before
6 discarding such container, unless the container may
7 be easily opened from the inside, shall be punished by
8 a fine of not more than one hundred dollars, or by
9 imprisonment for not more than one year, or both.
